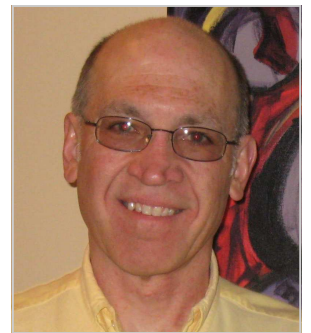


Featuring Susan Fell, LMSW
